#### FEED ST. MARY'S FEEDS ST. MARY'S:

During the first cycle of the allocation award grant from the Maryland Food Bank, Feed St. Mary's procured almost 13,000 pounds of food. As result of this serendipity, FSM has been able to supplement the good work being done in St. Mary's County by donating over 266 cases of food to approximately one dozen local pantries and soup kitchens.

The grant, which began earlier this summer, will continue to provide supplemental resources to local agencies through the next few months and will enable the cooperating partners to make a significant and tangible difference in alleviating hunger in our local community.

The Feed St. Mary's Warehouse continues to grow and evolve into a premier asset to those seeking to end food insecurity in St. Mary's County.
